What would I be expected to do?

You will be expected to offer practical help and support to other prisoners who find it difficult to cope; those prisoners who have been assessed as requiring varying levels of practical assistance. You will become part of a respected team of BUDDIES that provide an important role in the lives of men who need help with daily living.

This is a recognised full time roll across the prison and paid at enhanced orderly rates and forms part of the establishment Social Care service to prisoners in partnership with Devon County Council.

Successful applicants will receive training and support and possibly go on to achieve a higher level of competence through further training.
