Network condition

We carry out extensive network condition surveys every year. The condition parameters are analysed using prescribed rules in a nationally accredited Pavement Management System to assign a Road Condition Indicator (RCI) to lengths of road.

The RCIs are grouped into three bands and are assigned a colour.

Red – lengths of road in poor overall condition which are likely to require planned maintenance soon.

Amber – lengths of road where some deterioration is apparent which should be investigated to determine the optimum time for planned maintenance treatment.

Green – lengths of road where the carriageway is generally in a good state of repair.

The charts show the proportions of each road type that fall into each band.
