

## NOTICE OF MAKING OF AN ORDER

### HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 DEVON COUNTY COUNCIL (BRIDLEWAY NO. 66, UPLYME (DEVON) AND BRIDLEWAY NO. 10, LYME REGIS (DORSET)) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2016

The above order, made on 20<sup>th</sup> October 2016 under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980, will divert parts of public Bridleway No. 10, Lyme Regis (Dorset) and Bridleway No. 66, Uplyme (Devon) running from a route near to The Old Mill and mostly on the Devon side of the County Boundary to a route slightly further to the east of The Old Mill and mostly on the Dorset side of the County Boundary, as shown on the order map.

Any representations about or objections to the order must be sent in writing to the County Solicitor, Devon County Council, County Hall, Exeter, EX2 4QD not later than 4<sup>th</sup> January 2017. **Please state the grounds on which they are made.** Copies of any objections or representations received may be circulated to interested parties.

If no such representations or objection are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Devon County Council may confirm the order as an unopposed order. If the order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment, Food & Rural Affairs for confirmation, any representations or objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the order.
