PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2016

THIS Order is made by Devon County ("the authority") under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the authority that in the interests of owner of the land crossed by the bridleway described in paragraph 1 of this order it is expedient that the line of the way should be diverted.

The Landowner has agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this order and any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the way into a fit condition for use by the public.

East Devon District Council and Dorset County Council have been consulted concerning the making of the order as required by Section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

BY THIS ORDER:

1. The public rights of way over the land situate at The Old Mill in the parish of Uplyme in the Counties of Devon and Dorset and shown by bold continuous lines on the map contained in this order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this order shall be stopped up after 28 days from the date of confirmation of this order.
2. Notwithstanding this order, where immediately before the date on which the ways are diverted in pursuance of this order there is apparatus on under or over the ways belonging to the statutory undertakers for the purpose of carrying out their undertaking then such undertakers shall continue to have the same rights in respect of their apparatus as they would have had if this order had never been made.
3. There shall at the end of 28 days from the date of confirmation of this order be public bridleways over the land situate at The Old Mill in the parish of Uplyme in the Counties of Devon and Dorset described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by bold broken lines with crossbars in the intervals on the map contained in this order.

A to B Lyme Regis Bridleway 10 (15 metres)	From Point A (SY 3331 9332), a point in the County of Dorset to the northeast of The Old Mill, the way runs westwards along a track and across a stream at Point B (SY 3330 9331).	The whole width
B to C Uplyme Bridleway 66 (60 metres)	From Point B, the way continues in the County of Devon westwards and then northwards along a track to Point C (SY 3329 9336), being a point to the north of The Old Mill.	The whole width

PART 2 - DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF NEW WAY

Section of Way as Indicated on Map	Position	Width
A to D Lyme Regis Bridleway 10 (45 metres)	From Point A the way runs north-northwestwards to cross a stream at Point D* (SY 3330 9335), being a point on the Devon and Dorset County Boundary to the north of The Old Mill.	3.0 metres
D to C Uplyme Bridleway 66 (10 metres)	From Point D the way continues north-northwestwards to join the track at Point C.	3.0 metres

**A new bridle bridge will be provided by the Landowner at Point D to a specification agreed with the Devon and Dorset County Councils. The Landowner will be liable for maintenance and replacement of the bridge with a five percent contribution to be made by each of the County Councils if requested by the Landowner.*
