| Abbotskerswell | Abbotskerswell Parish Council maintains a stock of sandbags stored securely in a central location. The Flood Warden liaises with Teignbridge District Council to order and deliver sandbags. The contacts for sandbags are published in the village magazine and a leaflet of emergency contacts is circulated to residents annually. Transportation/collection of sandbags is the responsibility of the recipient. |

| Ashton | Ashton Parish Council stores sandbags near Blatchford Farm. For more information contact Philippa May 01647 252212. |

In an emergency, residents can access the store without phoning - however are asked to contact Stephen as soon as they can to let him know how many sandbags they have taken. |
| Dunchideock | Dunchideock Parish Council has a supply of sandbags in a village hall shed. The main contact is Lawrence Dow (833000). Sandbags are freely available to any resident. They should either collect bags themselves or arrange with a Village Hall or Parish Council committee member (see www.dunchideock.org.uk) to assist with delivery. Users of sandbags should advise Mr Dow of how many have been taken from the store. When bags are no longer required, if they are in good condition, they should be returned to the store. |
